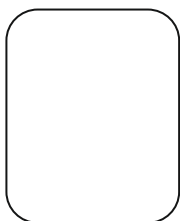

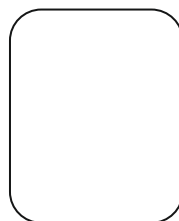

ABOUT SOCIETY FOR YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

Dr. Asha Sawardekar while working in “Provodoria” Rural development agency & other NGOs came in contact with many distressed people. She saw many ruined lives and, moved by their sufferings, she decided one day after retirement she will wipe out the tears of these people by undertaking a major project which will give relief and extend helping hand to them.

Her dream came into reality in the form of “Sanjeevan”. She established “Society for youth Development” on the 8th January 1978. The society was to undertake programs for the benefit of children, women, young men and women and old people.

Her colleagues Dr. Neela Vaidya and Mrs. Vasundhara Warkhedekar joined her in new endeavor and a committee was formed to carry forward this work. This year Society for Youth Development completed 40 years of service to the society. Sanjeevan have various projects today:

- 1) Arogyadham (recovery Home)
- 2) Nandadeep
- 3) Working Women and Girls Hostel
- 4) Skill Development Training Course
- 5) One year Home Nursing Course for the IXth passes students.

6) From 2013-14 Sanjeevan has started Higher Secondary School (Vocational)recognized by Goa Government and affiliated to Goa Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, Porvorim. It runs H.C.S.C. –(Health Care Science Course)- Vocational. After passing XII std. the student get ample opportunity of self employment and job opportunities in Private Hospitals.

GENERAL RULES

1. The school timing are between 8.45a.m. to 1.45p.m. However, the students may be required to come and attend the extra classes/ activities in the afternoon when scheduled.
2. Students should come to school in uniform, clean and neatly dressed.
3. The student has to wear the identity card and carry prospectus cum calendar to the school every day.
4. A student will be allowed to bring his/her vehicle to school provided he/she has the valid license to drive the same. The vehicle should be parked in the parking lot allotted.
5. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited. Severe action will be action taken against anyone committing this offence.
6. The students are expected to behave with decorum and follow the regulations of the Higher Secondary School. Persistent neglect of work or failure to respond promptly to official notices may punish even with dismissals.
7. Students shall not do anything either inside or outside the class/ school that will any way interfere with its orderly administration and discipline.
8. No student should communicate any information to or write about any matter dealing with the school administration to the press or any website.
9. Student will not be permitted to carry any electronic gadgets to the classrooms. Use of mobile phone in the school premises is strictly prohibited.
10. Any additional rules as and when it is introduced by the institution will be binding on the students

ADMISSION RULES

STD XI

1. A student seeking admission must apply in person in the prescribed application form along with parent/ guardian within a week from the date of declaration of the S.S.C.E./XI results.
2. Students passing the S.S.C Examination from the Goa Board and seeking admission to std XI class are required to submit the following:
 - i) Admission form duly completed in all respects.
 - ii) Original statement of marks of S.S.C. Exam along with two Xerox copies duly attested.
 - iii) Original school leaving certificate (shall not be return)
 - iv) Character certificate from the school last attended
 - v) Caste certificate if belong to SC/ST/OBC categories.
 - vi) Three copies of recent photograph (identity cards size)
3. Students who have passed the S.S.C. Exam or its equivalent from boards other than Goa Board produced eligibility certificate from the Goa Board besides the requirement state above before his/her case of admission to the school can be considered. A student producing provisional certificate of eligibility will be admitted at his/her risk on condition that he/she obtain confirm certificate of eligibility before the close of the academic year failing which his/her annual result will not be declared. The L.C. has to be counter signed by the Education authority of the area.
4. No application without the required documents in original shall be accepted.
5. Students of non Indian nationality should apply for admission through the Indian High Commissioner of their country.
6. No admission shall be regarded as duly granted unless it is confirmed by the Principal, the necessary fees have been paid to the school the admission is approved by the Board.
7. The admission is valid for a year only and has to be renewed for the subsequent year of study.
8. The principal reserve the right to refuse to admission to students whose passed academic record and conduct our considered or found to be unsatisfactory.
9. The student shall record the correct name and address of the parent/guardian in the admission form. It is the responsibility of the students to inform change of address, if any.

PROSPECTUS

10. No document shall be returned to any new admitant after the conformation of admission.
11. Candidates applying for admission to any other Higher Secondary School or Professional course should inform the Principal in writing at the time of admission and should subsequently submit proof of admission. After confirmation of admission the original leaving certificate will not be returned.

Internship in XIth std

From 1st July 4 students as per the muster roll will do 24 hrs duty (alternate days except school hours) at Sanjeevan Arogyadham. For 2nd month next 4 students will continue doing duty as above till at the end of year.

This duty will be consider in internal marks.

STD XII

1. Students who have enrolled for the previous year should apply for the admission to the higher class within one week after the declaration of the results of the final examination of std XI.
2. Admission for students coming from other Higher Secondary Schools will be solely at the discretion of the principal.
3. A student will be eligible to appear for the H.S.S.C of Examination of the Goa Board at the end of the second academic year provided that
 - i) He/she passes std XI
 - ii) Has kept up both the terms with a minimum of 75% attendance and attended all practical and completed the prescribed course successfully.
- iv) Attain the required std of conduct and academic.

Internship of Std XII

First five students of std XII will do their internship in Sanjeevan Aroghydharm recovery home for six months after finishing the final exam. They will work for 24hrs on alternate days they will be paid Rs.3000/- till declaration of result and after that Rs. 6000/- will be paid for month.

Internship at Aroghydharm is compulsory and passing certificate from Goa Higher Secondary Board will be issued only after completing internship.

We also have various Competitions for the skill development among the students we offer opportunity for our students to participate in interclass & inter higher secondary competitions exhibition to exhibit their talent

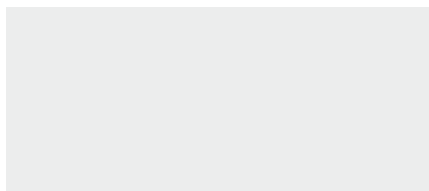
NSS:

TRAINING PROGRAMME



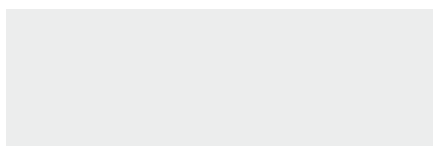
The student Nurses during this HCA (Nursing) Course are trained for more than six months in the subdistrict hospital Ponda under the guidance of doctors & qualified nurses .

During this course the students have to go on on-job training in the various hospitals private or government of their choice & have to successful complete the training and get certificate from the doctors of the hospital consult.

This on job training is part of syllabus and compulsory. The student nurses also have to visit the community for the health and hygiene serv survey in the villages for creating awareness among the villagers of various vaccinations, cleanliness, proper hygiene & family planning etc.

Our students will have to go compulsory in service training in the Sanjeevan's Arogyadham for basic nursing & make theme self habitual for night duty.

We aim at to give the best positive service to the society by providing good nurses which is the need of the day today.
